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Hey luminary Leslie Tagorda here with another episode, this time all about Chiron and the North Node meeting up in Aries. They do that exactly on Monday, February 19. And you are already feeling it. So let's dive in and discover what this is all about for changemakers leaders and entrepreneurs. Welcome to Star powered astrology for changemakers I have Leslie Tagorda. Your guide, a Hawaii born Filipino Jewish astrologer who loves navigating visionaries like you to the spiritual journey of your work so that you can be inspired to live by your chart and become the luminary leader you are born to be. Hello, hello, my friends. I am recording this on Sunday, February 18, which just right before the sun moves from Aquarius into Pisces, the last few months we'd have these like Aquarius pileups. And now we're moving into a Pisces pile up. And everything kind of feels a little bit concentrated in the sky. But this is an excellent concentration because this is truly opening us up into a new cycle. Now, I've been talking about Chiron, the wounded healer, and the Transiting north node, our collective soul potential. This these two energies and meeting up in 2024. And the time is here. I've been mentioning this at the end of 2023. Because I feel that if you are a change maker, you're a leader, you're an entrepreneur of some sort, that this is one of those big transit these big combinations of energies that are coming forward and asking us to awaken and step into our leadership. And so today I want to talk about what this Chiron and north north node meetup actually means. And I want to talk about what this means for you in creating a new cycle of leadership, a different type of leadership, what I like to call the wounded leader, although the wounded leader I can understand, get really, really misconstrued. Just because we think about just like the kinds of leaders who are, you know, in power grabs, and they're losing power, and so they take more control. And those are kind of like those, those hurts, like almost like I think of like a wild animal that's been trapped in the house like a really bad pain. And instead of like allowing people to help them, they lash out at others and try to have like more power and more control. That is not what I'm talking about in terms of wounded leadership. I think that the person who has the best kind of definition of what I mean for wounded leadership is Brene, brown Brene. Brown has been talking about vulnerability and shame for many, many years. And in the most recent and most recently, she's been talking about vulnerability in the workplace, especially in her books, daring greatly, and dare to lead and Brene Brown when she talks about vulnerability in the workplace or leadership Brene Brown says that the definition of vulnerability is uncertainty, risk and emotional exposure. She then goes on to share that vulnerability is not weakness. It's our

most accurate measure of courage. And that's what I truly see, when we think about this idea of the wounded leader. We can change this into the vulnerable leader. And what does it mean to be a vulnerable leader. So in Brene, Brown's book, dare to lead, she talks about the courage about vulnerable leadership, and she inspires people to lead by breaking down all of the research that she's done on shame on empathy, on values and changing the culture of leadership. And to me, she does a great job of inspiring people to take lead inspiring others to be vulnerable. But this is where I feel a lot of like, especially me and a lot of my clients come in, it's like how do we tap into that vulnerability? How are you meant to lead? Especially when there are no other role models or have input emotional or intuitive leaders and changemakers? Like us? How are we meant to guide others, especially when we have this multifaceted interests and capabilities? And how do you speak and present to your vulnerabilities and your mission and your vision with authenticity? Now Brene doesn't go into that, how that's where I kind of dive in because we can see that into the astrology chart, but I'm not going to talk about that right here. And right now, what I want to talk about is that how Chiron, your Chiron, well, I guess I'm going to talk about that right here now. Your Chiron, where Chiron lives in your chart, by what sign by what house by what aspects it has two different energies in your chart shows you your path of vulnerable leadership. Because Chiron the wounded healer, he he, you know, the longest I've done a few episodes on Chiron. So I'll let you go back and listen to Chiron. But long story short, is that Chiron the wounded healer can heal in others what He can't heal in himself. He had a couple of chronic wounds, the wounds of rejection, self sabotage so many different wounds that truly tap into the human experience. And in his healing journey and his healing path he goes, and he looks for ways to heal his chronic pains and ailments, and never really fully able to heal his own sense of rejection, his own sense of abandonment, his own sense of, of not enoughness, his own pain, chronic pain, that should have killed him and his left foot. He never was able to do that for himself But in his healing path and journey, he picked up so many different healing modalities and tools, that he was able to create this beautiful healing temple, where people came into his temple for healing and he was able to heal them. And that healing temple that he created, that is the symbolism for consent. He's not going around trying to try to fix everybody and you know, being the martyr and say, I'm going to heal you, I'm going to heal you, I'm going to heal you. That's not how it's working. People consent to becoming healed when they step into that temple, where he can then heal them. So long story short, the gist of it is, Chiron never was able to fully heal all of his maladies and his chronic because Quranic wounds emotionally, physically, spiritually, but he was able to heal in others what he wasn't able to heal in our in himself. And we all have Chiron in our chart somewhere, and wherever we have that Chiron shows us, what is that path to healing? Also, what is that path to leading. And so this particular transit coming back to this north node, and, and Chiron coming together tomorrow, we are absolutely on a new cycle of coming into our authentic, vulnerable leadership. So let's tap into that more. So just like a new moon, when the sun and the moon meet every month, we open up into a new cycle of intention. And this new cycle of intention. Whenever two planets meet up, whether, you know, in 2020, we had Saturn and Jupiter meetup. We have Saturn and Pluto media leader. We had Saturn, Jupiter and Pluto meetup. We had all those big meetups. And yes, when he when he was the beginning of a new cycle indeed, well, anytime two energies or planets come together, they are creating a new cycle, just like a new mood, a fresh beginning, a time of setting intentions and an awakening. Now that North Node, of course, is our collective soul potential. And Chiron that wounded healer, leader. I like to think of this meeting of Chiron and the North Node as the awakened collective leadership. This is your call to know yourself, know your healing path, know the gift of contribution. That's all of that in that vulnerable leadership aspect in your work and leadership. And this awakening this opening into this beginning fresh start of a new cycle is to see that your way meaning your journey, the questions that you've been looking to answer within yourself, how you're meant to contribute and how you were born to contribute to heal and lead.

All of this is awakening. And like you really you've already been feeling this call. Now. You know, of course when we think about these exact aspects, even though the exact aspect is happening tomorrow on February 19 2024, there's a whole lead up to Chiron and the North Node have been getting closer and closer and closer for months now. And they'll remain pretty close for a few more months. And so it's not like just like boom, we're here. You have been feeling this already. And so can you recognize that this is your time to decide how you are going to rise up and step up into your path of your vulnerable wounded healer leadership. Okay, So going back to Chiron, right Chiron so as mentioned the short cut of the summary of the story. Chiron is the wounded healer. And in Aries the question that Chiron is asking, is it safe to be me? Right? Aries is I am, I will go I will. I am my own person. I know myself and Chiron in Aries. Of course, absolutely. Aries represents one part of leadership, wounded leader. So the healer leader through their challenges and lived experiences like Brene Brown said all of their vulnerabilities. This wounded leader, has learned compassion, has learned vulnerability, has learned courage and has learned giving back. Isn't it beautiful that Chiron in the glyphs on the astrology chart is symbolized by a key. Now just really quickly, if you don't know what all these symbols are, and you want to learn what these symbols are and what they mean, and how what they mean in your work and your business. But going back that Chiron symbol is a key. And this key is literally your key to your leadership and your business success. Because Chiron represents again, I'm gonna say this over and over again, which you can't heal in yourself, but you can heal and others, Chiron and your journey of discovery and healing yourself takes you on your healing path. And this path is of discovery as you look two answers to your ultimate Chiron wound. And for most of us, our ultimate Chiron rules are going to revolve around around certain themes like, Am I safe? Am I enough? Do I belong? Do I matter? Does my voice matter to my feelings matter? All of these we can boil them down into these Chiron wounds. And again, I forget which episode that is. I've added into that into our notes. But in I've recorded an entire podcast on Chiron, and all of the buyside looking at the different wounds and how Chiron own story shows up in our own work. And so when we think about our own personal Chiron wounds, and of course, you know of Chiron is close to an angle, like our rising sign or midheaven or our icy or descendant caught your karma and Moon is probably a little bit more I call it a cute, more painful. If your Chiron is connected to your son or your moon, again, a little bit more painful. And then there's a whole generation of us between the 60s and the 80s, where Chiron was opposite Uranus. And to me that is the ultimate cycle breaker. Okay. And so whether you know, looking at your Chiron and how its aspected is really going to give you that story. It's going to make it super crystal clear and specific to you. Now part of your Chiron healing path is that all of that personal wisdom that you pick up looking to answer your Chiron wounds or heal parts of yourself whether this be therapy or self help, or a different healing modalities, or different groups and things like that they go to answer these parts of yourself and heal parts of yourself. This is your personal wisdom. And this is your Chiron journey. And this path that you take with your personal wisdom is answering your Chiron questions, and that personal wisdom, my friend is the gift that you were born to give back through your work and your leadership. It's beautiful how it works out. I love seeing my clients eyes just like open up when they come to their true Chiron gifts. Now we look at the North Node. Okay, so going again Chiron and Aries. That question is Is it safe to be me? Do I know myself? Right, this is such a such a like a base thing. Everybody has this. Okay, now the North Node in Aries. So the collective transiting north node is currently an Aries, it's an Aries all the 2024 and the North Node is our human or our collective consciousness stretching and moving towards and so of course in your natal chart, your north node is your soul potential. It's one of your purpose keys like where you're meant to move towards. There's there's a number of keys that are moving towards something and the North Node is absolutely that now when we're

moving towards because There's uncertainty because it's a little bit new. Because it's a little because of its uncertainty T and makes it a little bit scary. This becomes a stretch again, you have to intentionally move towards this. Now I say this human or collective, the collective we've. So this north node in Aries is a soul potential for me, for you for the collective we so that we can embrace and become the highest possibility of Aries. Now, I know this can be absolutely confusing an Aries because of the area's low vibes, like selfishness and hyper independence and stubbornness and conflict and all the kinds of bad GUC that Yvette Aries is so known for. But instead, the North Node is asking us to stretch and move into the evolution and the highest possibilities of Aries. knowing thyself, like knowing thyself, so truly, that's why astrology is such a gift. being your best self, walking your own path, not only walking your own path, knowing your own path, knowing the pace, not worrying about if cars are zipping by or you're moving too slow, or you're wanting to take the scenic route, you have your own path that Aries wants to take and pioneer, okay. And then lastly, one of the highest evolutions of Aries is that interdependence. It's a combination of both Libra of you know the, the in the in the dependency the shadows of like the people pleasing and the dependency of Libra, and then the and then the hyper individuality and hyper independence of areas, those kinds of shadows. But if we raise that up, interdependence means the mutual dependency on each other, meaning that when like a potluck, right, if we come to a party, and it's a potluck party, everybody brings a dish. Now, if everybody was bringing desserts, that's not gonna work. But personally, I don't like to bake. So that's great, I'm going to bring something to throw on the barbecue or the grill, or I'm going to bring an amazing salad. And my friend is going to bring something to bake and another friend is going to bring some like cocktails and things like that. So that's the interdependence is like knowing what we're super good at, and what we are here to contribute into that potluck of the world. And so that North Node in Aries is us all stretching into our sole potential of knowing ourselves being our best selves, walking our own path, and interdependence, knowing what we are meant to lead and contribute into the whole. And so individually the symbolisms of Chiron and Aries and north node in Aries. Well, now that they meet up in in in areas, like I mentioned earlier, we have a new awakening, a new cycle. So now, just like on a new moon, it's time to decide how you will rise up and step onto that path of wounded healer and leader. Now, I want to talk a little bit about what you're meant to stretch into. So what you need to reframe what you need to say yes to what you intentionally need to move forward into, and what you are meant to dismantle, and resist saying no to with this energy. So let's talk first about what we're stretching into and saying yes to so this north node and Chiron meetup energy is so perfect for you to know who you are, how know how you're meant to lead, right, that vulnerability part. I'm going to always come back to that wounded leadership in terms of like that vulnerability, of compassion, of acceptance of courage of giving back of empathy that is a true vulnerable leader and sharing your own stories. So knowing how you're meant to lead is what you're saying yes to sharing your stories of challenge without shame, but also not using it as a kind of clickbait either. It's like, you know, there's a fine line there. Right, but like really sharing with vulnerability and how you got to where you are seeing your wounds as challenges as the gifts that you are meant to contribute, right. Part of hiding some so many of our wounds in our machines is that we're actually not allowing the people who need to hear it to hear it like we're so we're hiding all those parts of ourselves. And so we're stretching into seeing our wounds and challenges and sharing them because these are the gifts that you're bringing to that global potluck of leadership. And so we're Also this, this, this phase between Chiron and the North Node is asking you to take a stand. It's asking you to be seen to be recognized. That is such a great part of that Aries energy. This energy is also asking you to empower your own sense of individuality, equality, and community. You're not just a silo standing on an island on your own, but you are an individual that is part and equal to a community. And then, of course, finding your interdependent people and communities, finding your people who like me if I like to bring things if they're on the barbecue and the salad

who are not depending on me to bake the cake, because I'm just gonna go buy a cake and it's not gonna be that good. And so not a baker. So now, what do you need to dismantle and resist? Okay, so with North Node and Chiron, this energy, this need of energy really wants you to face your fears. It wants you to face your fears of feeding. Of course, this world isn't designed hasn't been designed. It's changing. That's what we're doing right now. We're changing the faces of leadership in 2024. And there hasn't been leaders looking, you know, that look like you or me changing. And so now it's like, how can you be brave to lead, you know, thinking about things like persecution are not speaking up, or being victimized or not doing good enough, or failing or rejection, all of those things come face to face with what it is that you are fearful for stepping up to be seen. Because once you can come face to face with that, you can start to make different decisions, so that you can step up and be seen by your people. This energy also wants you to face your shames. Okay, how can we remove shames of wounds or challenges or differences? Shame is is very, very, very powerful. And especially, you know, as you're, at least from me, when I was younger, conformity, I'm a Gen X person. And conformity is one of those things that was really instilled in us. And so big, being a little bit bigger body, having freckles, having curly hair, having all of these different things that were different about me, I was just like a walking boat of shame. And so this energy is saying, Hey, if you still have any shame, come face to face with it. Ask the shame when it's trying to protect, protect you from and is that still true? Okay. Now, the North Node and Chiron also wants you to face why you're hiding your and denying your strength. So a little bit different from shame. Meaning, it's like if you have strengths that are maybe more emotional or intuitive, maybe you're still hiding or denying them, because you think that people won't value them. Well, these are the energies, the intuitive and emotional strengths that are really coming into the fore that we really need. Because when people feel safe, that's that emotional aspect, that emotional intelligence. When people feel safe, when they feel seen when they feel accepted, when they feel belonging, again, our emotional strengths, that's when true change can happen. So we're starting to see that there, we need all kinds of strengths. And so if you felt any part of your own particular strengths that you want to hide or denied, and you're trying to, you know, do all these other things to make you seem different. That's working against your authenticity. And so really, you're coming face to face with what are my strengths and am I hiding or denying them? Of course, Astrology can tell you how to do that. Now of course, this energy also wants you to face your systems of inner personal and personal and different types of systemic oppression. Okay? How are you know, those these systems of oppression that we all live and breathe under will make us hide and deny parts of self ourselves will make us feel shame will make us feel fearful, fearful of stepping up, so maybe I should have put this first. Like what Inner Inner oppressor or systems of oppression? Are we still holding on to and upholding within our own lives and work that we need to really kind of break down even more? You've been doing this for a few years now. So I feel like that work never is ever complete. So keep on breaking it down. It's just like, you know, gotta clean up house every day. sweep the floors every day, do the dishes every day, you know, do what you need to do. So things don't build up. And then lastly, with North Node and Chiron meeting up, I want you to face why you think you can do it alone. Because you can't. Okay? That not one single person can do it alone. Again, we're not an island alone. We are not silos. We need witnessing. We need community, we need help. What no matter what, whether you're writing an article or building a business or being a leader, we are never doing this alone. So finding your people and really uncovering mindset or belief sets that say that you have to do this alone, because you won't get very far when you're doing this alone. Okay. So, again, in summary, what does this mean for you as a change maker, entrepreneur or leader? Well, Chiron in North Node meeting up starts a new cycle of awakening, and you're one of a kind leadership. Now Chiron and north node don't have a regular meeting path because they're, you know, North Node changes every 19 and a half years or so Chiron changes every 50 Year 50 year orbits, north node, 19 year orbit, and so they don't meet up regularly. And so

the last time I think was 2008, and Aquarius, but this new cycle, this, this random cycle has already been building and awakening, you are one of a kind leadership. This energy wants you to recognize that you're born to lead simply because you have been on your healing path. And now know that your vulnerabilities are your strength, your lived experiences and the work you've done to heal yourself to make you a wise compassionate, courageous and generous leader are absolutely your gifts. The world needs more of leaders like you right now. Will you recognize your way that makes you a consensual contributor, right? Again, consensual consent is so important here. Don't help the people who haven't asked you for help. Don't try to fix your parents, don't try to fix your family. Don't try to fix the family unit. Don't try to fix your coworker. Unless they consciously ask you, Hey, I need help they come to you, your clients, there's always consent there, because they have paid you for, for for transformation. So you can always double check on consent, I love to always talk about consent is like is it okay? If we talk about this challenging thing, if you don't want to talk about it? And you know, always kind of inviting to go into that next deeper level? And then lastly, what do you want your leadership to look like? Who do you want it to help? And how will it change the world? So my friends, I'm super excited about this aspect. It's one of the aspects that I've been looking towards for a few years. Now. Of course, I'm a little bit biased because I've gone through my Chiron return. Chiron just plays such a huge role in just my work.
